

Cherry Lumber













Cherry wood tends to be beloved among woodworkers. It lends an air of sophistication furniture pieces and kitchen cabinets alike. It also brings a richness to desks, doors and floors.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The heartwood of cherry varies from rich red to reddish brown and will darken with exposure to light and with age. The sapwood is a creamy white. The wood has a straight-grain, a fine, uniform, smooth and satin texture and naturally may contain small gum pockets and pith flecks.

WORKING PROPERTIES

Cherry is easy to machine, glues and nails well and when stained and sanded, produces a smooth finish. It dries fairly quickly and with moderately hight shrinkage but is dimensionally stabled after being kiln dried.

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

Cherry is of medium density and has good bending properties. It has low stiffness and medium shock and strength resistance.
