



Marine Grade AB Plywood



Marine Grade is the highest quality Douglas Fir and Western Larch plywood. It has a variety of uses and is excellent in high moisture applications.

- Slow growth inland Douglas Fir and Western Larch yield fine grained, smooth faces
- All Group 1, Structural 1 Species
- Manufactured in Kalispell, MT, USA

FACES:

• "A" grade faces shall be limited to a total of nine repairs in a 4'x 8' panel

BACKS, CENTERS AND CORES:

- All backs, centers and inner plies shall be "B" grade or better and shall be full length and full width
- Neither edge of a panel shall have any cross band gap or edge splits in excess of 1/8" wide or 4 in number. No inner ply laps are allowed.

CONSTRUCTION & THICKNESS:

- Thickness / ply count
 - 1/4" 3 Ply
 - 3/8" 4 Ply
 - 1/2" 5 Ply
 - 5/8" 6/7 Ply
 - 3/4" 7 Ply
- Panel thickness up to 1"
- Scarfed lengths 4' x 10'
- Full thickness
