### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The sapwood is creamy white and may be streaked. The heartwood varies from pale yellowish-brown to olive green. The green color in the heartwood will tend to darken on exposure to light and turn brown. The wood has a medium-to-fine texture and is straight-grained.

It is a versatile wood that is easy to machine, plane, turn, glue, and bore.
